Communication and Support

- "How can I reach you in a heart health emergency?"
- "What is your approach to patient education and preventive heart health?"

Treatment and Management Strategies

- "How do you involve patients in their heart health management plans?"
- "Can you provide an example of how you've handled a complex heart health case?"

Coordination with Other Health Professionals

- "Do you collaborate with cardiologists or other specialists for comprehensive heart care?"
- "How do you ensure continuity of care if I need specialist intervention?"
